- 1. Article Title 1 Point
 - a. What is the exact Title of your Article?
- 2. Article Topic 1 Point
 - a. What is the topic of your Article?
- 3. Article Source 2 Points
 - a. Where did you get the article (ex. Newspaper, Internet, Magazine...etc)
 - b. Article is stapled to the back of your assignment
- 4. Summary of the Article 8 Points
 - a. Briefly in your own words, summarize the contents of the article.
 - b. Four (4) sentences minimum
- 5. Reaction 6 Points
 - a. Take a position contained in the article.
 - b. How do you feel about this topic/event?
 - c. How does this topic/event affect you?
 - d. Three (3) sentence minimum
- 6. How does this topic/event impact your community or even the world? 2 Points
 - a. Two (2) sentence minimum
